Flight with two aboard in Southeast overdue

JUNEAU -- The Coast Guard is searching for two Juneau men overdue from a flight out of the city.

Fifty-six-year-old Brian Andrews and his son, 24-year-old Brandon Andrews, were on a Cessna 182.

They left Juneau at about 3:45 p.m. Saturday on their way to Young's Lake on north Admiralty Island about 20 miles southeast of Juneau.

The Coast Guard says the plane was equipped with an emergency locator transmitter but it had not been activated.

The agency received word of the overdue aircraft at 7:30 p.m. and launched a search with a helicopter.

A second helicopter and the Cutter Liberty from Auke Bay was searching Sunday.
